Thank you for considering a Community Service Project that will benefit our patients, residents, and staff at CentraState! There are a variety of opportunities for volunteers of any age to serve their community as well as accumulate Community Service Hours. Details for each project, including supplies, directions, guidelines, and requirements, are listed below.

Donation Drop Off ~ Donations are accepted Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9:30am-11:30am or 1:30pm-3:30pm. Please come to Outpatient Entrance 4 and call 732-294-2622 when you arrive. No appointment necessary. We do not accept donations on Holidays that fall on these days. Please let us know when you call if we need to bring a cart to carry donations.

Please note that the *Donation Intake Form* from our website **MUST** be printed and filled out when you drop off your donation or we cannot accept it.

***All donated items must be new, and a **receipt must be presented** with all purchased donations**

A Certificate of Hours is provided at drop-off. While we can attempt to fill out any requested school paperwork, we cannot provide a letter of service for donations.

Comfort Items

At this time, these are our most requested and needed items
